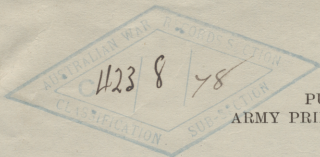

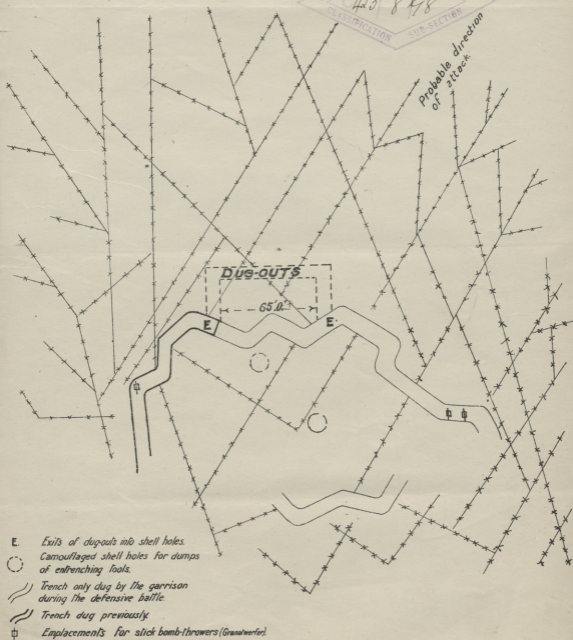

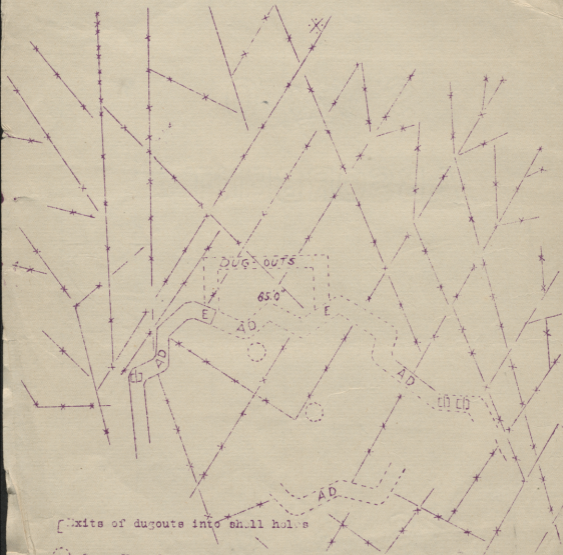

[Exits of dugouts into shell holes

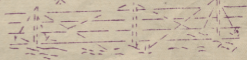
○ Camouflaged shell holes for dumps of entrenching tools
